Organised by the STLD, ALD and Clay Paky, the KOI Awards has made several changes this year: In addition to the Rock sector being renamed 'Concert Touring & Events', each sector will now contain a new category as follows: Video Graphic Display (for TV), Video Electronic Content (for Concert Touring And Events) and Projection Design (for Theatre). Each sector breaks down into the following categories:

'Television' includes awards for: Drama, Light Entertainment, Small Studio, Events & Video Graphic Display. 'Concert Touring & Events' includes: Concert Touring Stage, Concert Touring Arena, Live Events & Video Electronic Content. 'Theatre' includes: Dance, Opera, Play, Musicals & Projection Design. Finally, the Enrico Caironi Award For Lifetime Recognition will be presented to an individual who has made an outstanding impact on the industry . . .

Nominations will close in July, with the announcement of the shortlist in August. The award ceremony itself will be held on 6 October.
